

PE/GAMES

Striking and Fielding, Tennis and Athletics

The children will develop their striking and fielding techniques in game-based situations and will be introduced to various game positions. They will develop running and jumping techniques with increased height and distance and participate in a range of athletic events.



Weaving - Terra Fuller

The children will look at the work of Terra Fuller and the key features of weaving to inspire their own weaving designs and ideas using clay and cellophane. They will evaluate their artwork using technical vocabulary.

PSHE

Health and Wellbeing

The children will explore healthy choices and habits whilst looking at expressing feelings. They will develop an understanding of their own personal strengths and achievements and how to manage setbacks. They will also learn about the different risks and hazards and discuss safety in the local environment and unfamiliar places.

I Don't Like Poetry - Joshua Seigal Julius Caesar - Shakespeare

Through role play and script writing, the children will explore key themes including ambition, power of speech and identity. They will read and perform a variety of different poems which will help them to create their own.

HISTORY British Monarchs

This term the children will learn about some of the most influential British Monarchs over the past 1000 years, and explore how their powers have changed, and the reasons behind it.

GEOGRAPHY

The Water Cycle and Climate

The children will develop an understanding of the human and physical geography of water cycles within the UK and how this compares to parts of Europe and its climate.

FRENCH

We will be learning the vocabulary for colours, fruit and food as well as the days of the week and months of the year.

RE

What are the features of Places of Worship?

We will look at different religions and places of worship. They will develop an understanding of the various features of different faiths.

What role do Religious figures have?

Pupils will also research a variety of religious stories to gain an insight into how religious figures have an impact on core belief.

SCIENCE

Animals and Humans

The children will study the skeletal structures of animals and humans and what they need to eat to survive.

Plants

We will learn the names for parts of a plant, their function, and discover what they need to grow well.

MUSIC

Bringing us together - Disco

This topic is focused around a song: "Bringing Us Together" - a Disco song about friendship, peace, hope and unity

Reflect, Rewind and Replay

We will revisit songs and musical activities, the context for the History of Music and the beginnings of the Language of Music.

DT Scones

The children will design and make a sweet or savoury scone. They will learn to use kitchen equipment hygienically and safely before tasting and evaluating their finished product.
