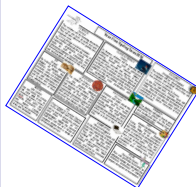

The School Photographer will visit both Schools on **Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> September** to take single headshots and sibling photographs.

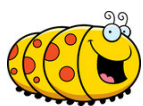


A proof will be sent home, together with details of how to order photographs. Families who wish for a group photograph please speak to the school office.
