CORE SUBJECTS



Reading

Through reading 'Stolen Spear' and 'Rosa Parks' children will explore resilience, friendship and courage while learning how Rosa Parks became an inspirational role model.



Writing

The children will use their fiction and non-fiction texts to inspire writing across a range of genres such as instructions, diary entries, setting descriptions, biographies and letters.



Science

The children will classify rocks by their properties, explore fossilisation and soil formation, study Mary Anning and investigate soil layers.



Geography

By comparing physical and human features across the United Kingdom and Europe, children will develop map and atlas skills to locate features.



History

The children will learn about Prehistoric Britain, exploring how life changed from the Stone Age to the Iron Age and comparing it with modern life using artefacts.



Art

Using watercolours, the children will explore landscapes and create their own artwork inspired by the techniques and ideas of Andrew Jenkin.



PSHE

The children will explore, identity, friendship and belonging, while developing strategies to manage emotions, worries and relationships.



PE

Teamwork and coordination will be developed through basketball, football and benchball. Creative movement in disco dance will also be explored.



DT

After investigating pulleys and levers, the children will design and create moving pictures, applying their understanding of simple mechanical systems.



RE

The children will explore how beliefs influence worship and lifestyles while investigating different types of texts within sacred writings.



Computing

Using Scratch, the children will create animated scenes, write algorithms, identify errors and debug programs using logical reasoning to achieve goals.



Music

Through studying rhythm and melody in an R&B song, the children will compose similar pieces and perform confidently using glockenspiels.



French

The children will be introduced to French and will learn greetings, introduce themselves, and use songs to practise the names of colours and shapes.
